





LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

California Legislature Wraps Up Eventful 2024 Session

As September came to a close, so did California's 2024 legislative session, concluding a year marked by intense activity and legislative achievements. With over 2,500 bills proposed, the session was nothing short of bustling. Ultimately, 1,556 bills made it to Governor Gavin Newsom's desk. out of which 1,367 were signed into law while 189 were vetoed. This legislative year also featured a special session initiated by the Governor to address surging gas prices, culminating in the passage of ABX2-1 on October 14. This critical measure now requires oil refiners to uphold minimum fuel inventories as a safeguard against supply disruptions and sudden price increases.

Southwest California Legislative Council's Insights

At the session's conclusion, the Southwest California Legislative Council (SWCLC) revisited its legislative positions, contrasting them against those of local state legislators. This year, the SWCLC engaged with 76 bills—one of its most active

years on record. Unlike previous years, 2024 saw the council support more bills than it opposed. This shift was due in part to the state's budget deficit, which naturally led to the demise of many costly bills unable to garner sufficient support.

Legislative Scorecard: A Closer Look

The SWCLC's analysis highlighted key alignments and discrepancies among local legislators:

Senate Standings: Senator Seyarto and Senator Ochoa-Bogh aligned closely with the council's stances, each scoring an impressive 88%. Senator Roth, meanwhile, scored 55%, showcasing a more moderate alignment.

Assembly Performance: In the Assembly, Assemblymember Sanchez earned an 83% alignment score, followed by Assemblymember Essay-

li at 68%, and Assemblymember Jackson at 58%.

What's Next for 2025

Looking to the future, California is preparing for a new two-year legislative cycle that will introduce fresh faces and new priorities to the state legislature. Topics such as the economy, gas prices, climate change, and advancements in artificial intelligence are anticipated to dominate discussions and legislative agendas in 2025.



LAKE ELSINORE | Steady Price Growth as Buyer Interest Holds

Lake Elsinore's housing market continued to see steady growth in October 2024, with the median home sold price reaching \$630,000, up 3.3% year-over-year. Although the total inventory decreased by 2.2% to 306 homes, demand remained stable, as homes averaged 41 days on the market, a slight increase but still indicative of a competitive environment.

The market shows resilience, particularly in the mid-tier price range, where buyers remain active despite the tightening supply. While overall sales activity is balanced, price growth in Lake Elsinore reflects sustained interest from buyers seeking affordable options within Riverside County, keeping the city favorable for sellers.


REVIVING LAKE ELSINORE: A BOLD PLAN TO RESTORE ITS NATURAL BALANCE

INNOVATIVE NANOBUBBLE TECHNOLOGY - A NEW ERA OF ECOLOGICAL RESTORATION

Lake Elsinore's namesake lake has always been central to the City's identity, but it has faced significant water quality challenges over the years. In response to these persistent issues, the Lake Elsinore City Council took a decisive step in 2023, by passing its first comprehensive Lake Management Plan. This ambitious plan introduces innovative strategies and collaborative initiatives designed to address the lake's problems at their roots. Instead of seeking a single, quick-fix solution, the City is undertaking a series of projects aimed at facilitating the lake's natural healing over time.

The first major project under this plan was the installation of a pilot nanobubble barge in February 2024. This advanced barge has the capacity to pump 3.5 million gallons of water daily, injecting the lake's bottom with oxygen-rich nanobubbles. The technology behind nanobubbles is remarkable—they are approximately 2,500 times smaller than a grain of salt. Their minuscule size makes them naturally buoyant, allowing them to remain suspended in the water column for extended periods, which significantly increases the efficiency of oxygen transfer.





By enhancing the oxygen levels at the lake's bottom, these nanobubbles play a crucial role in the ecological restoration process. They facilitate the breakdown of organic materials and help limit the release of phosphorus into the water column through a process known as internal loading. Improved oxygenation is essential for maintaining the lake's ecological balance and overall health.

The success of the pilot barge has been outstanding, surpassing the City's expectations. This success led to the acquisition of two additional barges, which were installed in October 2024. With all three barges now operational, the lake receives an impressive 5,500 pounds of oxygen each day. This concerted effort marks a significant milestone in the ongoing journey to restore Lake Elsinore's

water quality.

These initiatives are not just technical achievements; they represent a renewed commitment to preserving Lake Elsinore's vital role in the community. By investing in these advanced technologies and collaborative efforts, the city is ensuring that the lake can continue to be a cherished and healthy resource for generations to come.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN COPD AND EMPHYSEMA?


If you have breathing difficulties, it may be due to a chronic condition that causes damage to your lungs. Aside from asthma, two of the most common disorders that affect the lungs are chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and emphysema. Wondering what the similarities and differences are between these two conditions? Here are answers to frequently asked questions about these lung diseases.

What is COPD?

Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) refers to a group of lung diseases that result in breathing difficulties due to lung damage and limitations in airflow. The most common symptoms of COPD are frequent coughing, excessive mucus production, shortness of breath, chest tightness and wheezing. COPD is most often caused by cigarette smoking and exposure to second-hand smoke or respiratory irritants in the workplace. Many people with COPD have emphysema, which is a specific type of lung damage that falls under the COPD umbrella. Other COPD conditions include chronic bronchitis and refractory asthma.

What is emphysema?

Emphysema is a specific form of COPD characterized by progressive damage to the tiny air sacs in the lungs, called alveoli, that help you breathe. This makes it difficult to move air in and out of the lungs and pass oxygen into the bloodstream. Symptoms are similar to those of COPD, since it is a type of COPD, with the most common one being increasing breathlessness. Emphysema is most commonly caused by cigarette smoking, although exposure to smoke and respiratory irritants may also contribute to the condition. Addition-



ally, a genetic defect called alpha-1 antitrypsin deficiency can cause emphysema to occur at an early age.

Can you have both COPD and emphysema?

Since emphysema is a type of COPD, everyone who has emphysema has COPD. However, you can have COPD without having emphysema.

When should you see a doctor?

If you have any of the following symptoms, it's a good idea to see a doctor so it can be determined if you have COPD or emphysema:

- Shortness of breath, especially if it is getting progressively worse
- A persistent cough, especially if it produces excessive mucus or phlegm
- Chest tightness or wheezing when breathing
- Frequent respiratory infections

How is COPD diagnosed?

If you have potential symptoms of COPD, a doctor will take a detailed health history and perform a physical exam. Other tests that may also be done include:

- Chest x-ray
- CT scan
- Spirometry

(which measures the amount and speed of the air you blow out)

- Oximetry or arterial blood gas (which measures the oxygen in your blood)
- Lung volume test

(which measures the volume of air in the lungs)

• Diffusing capacity test

(which shows how easily oxygen enters the bloodstream)

• Exercise test

(which can evaluate shortness of breath during exercise)

Can COPD be cured?

There is no cure for COPD, but treatment and lifestyle changes can improve symptoms and prevent further lung damage. Early diagnosis and treatment help improve your quality of life and slow the progression of the disease.





