

Some of our most popular events include the Summer Concert Music Series at Lake Elsinore Casino and the Live at the Lakefront free community concerts at Launch Pointe. In addition the City hosts the Dream Extreme Fishing Derby, Kid's Fishing Derby, Jet Boat Races, Jet Ski Races, Mud/Flow Fun Runs, Numerous Ski Diving Events, Summer Car Cruises in Historic Downtown Lake Elsinore, Movies in the Park, Lake Elsinore Storm Baseball, the Annual Mariachi Fest, the Annual Taco Fest, the Annual Dia De Los Muerto Celebration, and the Annual Winterfest.





LEGISLATIVE SESSION RECAP: ADVOCATING FOR SOUTHWEST RIVERSIDE COUNTY BUSINESSES

The first year of the 2025–26 legislative session has wrapped up, concluding a busy period of activity in Sacramento. The Lake Elsinore Valley Chamber of Commerce, working in partnership with the Southwest California Legislative Council, has remained engaged in making sure that the interests of local employers and business owners are heard at the state level.

This session, lawmakers introduced more than 2,800 bills. Of those, 1,124 were signed by the Governor, 123 were vetoed, and roughly 1,100 became two-year bills that will return for further review in 2026. Throughout the process, the Chamber's team tracked legislation, met with decision-makers, and took official positions on 44 measures that directly impact the business community.

The Legislative Scorecard showed continued support from regional representatives for policies that promote a strong business environment. Senator Kelly Seyarto led the way with a 97% alignment with the Council's positions. He was followed closely by Assemblymember Kate Sanchez at 96%, Senator Rosilicie Ochoa-Bogh at 91%, and Assemblymember Natasha Johnson at 89%. Assemblymember Corey Jackson earned a 48% rating, reflecting a different approach on several key issues.

Among the major legislative developments this year was the passage of Senate Bill 72, authored by Senator Anna Caballero, known as the California Water for All measure. This law establishes new long-term goals for water supply and updates the state's approach to managing this essential resource. By uniting local governments, farmers, and communities, the measure seeks to create a more dependable



and sustainable water system for California's future.

Another important success for local employers came early in the session when Senate Bill 310 failed to advance. The proposal sought to roll back recent reforms to the Private Attorneys General Act (PAGA). During meetings in Sacramento, members of the Southwest California Legislative Council emphasized that the bill would have reopened costly and unnecessary legal risks for businesses. Its defeat helped preserve one of the most significant pro-employer reforms enacted in recent years.

Progress was also made on insurance issues through Assembly Bill 226, authored by Assemblymember Lisa Calderon. The bill strengthens California's Fair Plan, which helps homeowners who are unable to obtain coverage through the private market. The new law aims to stabilize the plan's finances and address the rising costs associated with property insurance.

Not every proposal made it across the finish line. Assembly Bill 1400, introduced by Assemblymember Esmeralda Soria, would have allowed select community colleges to offer bachelor's degrees in nursing. The Governor vetoed the measure due to cost and implementation concerns. Senate Bill 7, by Senator Jerry McNerny, was also vetoed. That bill would have limited employers' ability to use artificial intelligence in hiring and management

decisions. The business community viewed the veto as a positive outcome, citing concerns that the restrictions could have slowed innovation and increased compliance costs.

Outside the legislative process, a federal court temporarily halted enforcement of Senate Bill 399, which restricts employer communications related to labor and political topics. The pause allows for further review of the law's constitutionality and provides employers with some clarity while the case proceeds.

When the Legislature reconvenes in January, more than 1,000 two-year bills will return for debate. Lawmakers are expected to focus on workforce development, housing, taxation, and the regulation of emerging technologies.

The Lake Elsinore Valley Chamber of Commerce will continue to advocate for policies that help local businesses succeed. By staying active in the policy arena and working closely with lawmakers, the Chamber will ensure that the Lake Elsinore business community remains represented in key discussions that shape our regional economy.

The Chamber also welcomes Lake Elsinore's newest City Councilmember, Michael Carroll, and looks forward to working with him in support of the local business community. In addition, the Chamber is eager to see strong representation from newly elected Assemblymember Natasha Johnson, whose leadership will be an important voice for Lake Elsinore in Sacramento.




